

Portfolio & Programming

Our curriculum is based on Early Years Learning Framework, planning to scaffold on children's interests to create experiences that cultivate their own natural desire to learn, giving them lifelong tools to question, seek and succeed.

Every child will have a personal, confidential portfolio comprising of;

- Child profile
- Goals from families and educators
- Observations & learning stories
- Objectives for further development

Apart from our daily program, we also have Mini Maestro (Music incursion) every week during school term.

Kinder Program

Our funded Kinder program provides a sessional kindergarten experience while also providing long day care to support working families. Existing families at TREL are automatically eligible for a place in our kinder program.

What do we offer?

- Bush kinder, once/ twice per week
- Second Language Program (Mandarin), twice per week
- Various incursions/ excursions, including community walk, library visits, Woodwork/ science/ animal incursions etc.

Q & A

Q: Do you have a Sun smart policy?

A: Yes we do, children & educators will wear hats and appropriate clothing when outside. We also ask that children come to TREL with sunscreen applied. The sunscreen will be reapplied every two hours. (Please refer to our Sun smart policy).

Q: What to bring to the centre?

A: bags/ backpacks, appropriate spare clothing, water bottle, sun smart hat.

Please label all of your child's clothes and belongings.

Q: Do you charge fees when my child is sick/ families go on holidays?

A: Yes we charge full fees. (Please refer to our fees policy)

Q: When should I not send my child to the service?

A: Any cold symptoms (runny nose, temperature, cough), diarrhoea, vomiting, rashes, irritability, unusually tired / lethargic. (Please refer to our sick children policy)

Q: How can families be involved?

A: You can be involved in the Centre's Management Committee. Your involvement can be as formal or active as you like as time permits. We can arrange meetings with your child's educator at a time that suits you throughout the year, and offer email, Storypark, newsletters, and of course, strong verbal communication on daily basis!

Service information

TREL is a not-for-profit community based centre. It is managed by a Committee of Management, which consists of parents who have children in the centre.

TREL is licensed for 44 children, exceeding for all areas of National Quality Standard. The centre's operation hours are from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday. We are closed for approximately two to three weeks at the end of the year for Christmas breaks and on public holidays.
